Dear sirs,

Please be informed that the flag requirements for Electro-Technical Officer (ETO) are prescribed by regulation No (338) in 2016 issued by the Minister of Transportation in harmony with the mandatory minimum requirements for certification of electro – technical officers specified by the STCW convention and its Code through regulation (III/6) and section (A-III/6) of the STCW Code and can be stated as following:-

1- Every electro technical officer serving on a seagoing ship powered by main propulsion machinery of 750 kw propulsion power or more shall hold certificate of competency.

2- Every candidate for certification shall:

- .1 be not less than 18 years of age .
- .2 have completed not less than (12) months of combined workshop skills training and approved seagoing service of which not less than (6) months shall be seagoing service as part of an approved training programme which meets the requirements of section (A-III/6) of the STCW and in documented in an approved training record book, or otherwise, not less than (36) months of combined workshop skills training and approved seagoing service of which not less than (30) months shall be seagoing service in the engine department.
- .3 have completed approved education and training and the standard of competence specified in section (A-III) of the STCW Code; and.
