1. The Government of the National Unity, Libya, has received financing from the African Development Bank (AfDB) toward the cost of the “Strategic Transport Sector Study in Libya” project and intends to apply part of the agreed amount for this grant to payments under the contract for conducting **Preparation of a Strategic Study for the Transport Sector in Libya**.
2. General Objectives of the Project: The Project aims to enhance the capacity of the Transport sector in Libya through the preparation of a comprehensive strategic study that identifies opportunities and challenges, sets a roadmap for future development, and focuses on analyzing the current situation, assessing needs, and proposing policies and strategies to enhance the efficiency, effectiveness, and sustainability of the Libyan Transport sector.
3. The Ministry of Transport in Libya now invites eligible Consulting Firms to indicate their interest in providing these services. Interested Consulting Firms must provide complete and comprehensive information indicating that they are qualified to perform these services:
 - Brochures with full description of technical and organizational capacities, availability of appropriate skills and resources, etc.;
 - Proven experience in carrying out similar assignments in the Transport sector (list of similar projects undertaken in the preparation of national or regional Transport strategies);
 - Strong technical and institutional capacities, with proven experience in working with MDBs, International Institutions or Donor Agencies;
 - Availability of the qualified, multidisciplinary team along with biographies of key experts involved in the project’s implementation;
 - Any other technical information that may support their qualification for participation in this tender.
4. Consulting Firms may constitute joint ventures to enhance their chances of qualification. **The short-listing criteria are:**
 - The Consulting Firms should have at least 15 years of experience in engineering consultation, transport strategies, and any relevant Transport sector studies at a country/regional scale.
 - At least 2 completed similar assignments/tasks in the last 5 years in strategic studies for Transport sector strategies including preparing and designing feasibility studies, environmental and social studies, detailed design, and this for Roads, Railways, Air and Maritime Transport.
 - Familiarity with the environmental, social and regulatory context of Libya or similar regions.
 - Working experience of Donors funded projects is an asset.
 - Portfolio of relevant projects (e.g. documentaries, platforms, communications and marketing projects, etc.) is required to be presented with the Expression of Interest letter-EOI, along with supporting documents (company profile, registration, key experts’ bios).
5. Eligibility criteria, the establishment of the short-list and the selection procedure shall be in accordance with the African Development Bank’s “**Procurement Framework**” dated October 2015, which is available on the Bank’s website at <https://www.afdb.org> using **Consultant Qualification Selection (CQS) method**.
